Music Update 2016 Choir, Classroom & Instrumental Music

The Music Room and Office is located in the Activity Hall.

All R - 7 classes receive one weekly Classroom Music lesson with Mrs Jordan Pfeiffer (Mon & Tues) or Mrs Robyn Videon (Tues, Wed, Thurs). Robyn also teaches Senior Choir, as well as looking after the Instrumental Music Program. Classroom Music lessons include singing, movement, learning the 'language' of music, playing classroom percussion instruments – both untuned & tuned, preparing for performance and experiencing music in different contexts.

Recorder tuition included in all Yr 1,2 & 3 classes in 2016, in Semester 2.

Senior (Festival) Choir – Terms 1,2 & 3

All Yr 5, 6 & 7 students are invited to 'Come'n'Try' choir for 3 weeks, beginning on Wed. Feb 18th. The Choir is then formed, with a commitment required until end of Term 3. All students/families should consider taking this opportunity at least once in their Primary School years.

Instrumental Music

At Flagstaff Hill R–7 School, we recognize the overall benefits gained by learning and playing a Musical Instrument. Qualified Instrumental Teachers are invited into our school, and we allow students time out of their regular classroom to attend lessons – usually ½ an hour. Our annual Music night is held mid-year, and opportunities arise to perform at Assemblies and in Classroom Music lessons throughout the year.

With the exception of Strings (violin, viola & 'cello), all associated tuition payments are arranged directly between the students' families and instrumental teachers. No tuition fees are payable for Strings lessons as they are provided by DECD through the Instrumental Music Service.

Our school Music Department has many instruments available for hire-a very economical way to get started! Currently, there are flutes, clarinets, violins, 'cellos, trumpets & trombones available.
