School to provide:	A cricket kit which includes four sets of pads, four sets of gloves, two helmets, two bats, one pair of wicket-keeping gloves, one set of stumps and boundary markers Modified cricket balls (Kookaburra Softaball, Platypus Junior Softie) Minimum of one parent to be at the game to look after the team
Uniform:	School shirt to be worn, white pants and white wide brimmed hat are optional school uniform is acceptable, sunscreen and water bottle

'A' & 'B' Grade Cricket

Age Group:	A Grade: Year 6/7 B Grade: Year 5/6
Description:	Advanced cricket games for older children
No. of players:	8 per side
When:	Saturday mornings from 8.30-11.30am
Where:	At participating Primary School Grounds
School to provide:	A cricket kit which includes four sets of pads, four sets of gloves, two helmets, two bats, one pair of wicket-keeping gloves, one set of stumps and boundary markers Cricket balls (Kookaburra Commander (B Grade) 142g Leather Ball) Minimum of one parent to be at the game to look after the team
Uniform:	School shirt to be worn, white pants and white wide brimmed hat are optional school uniform is acceptable, sunscreen and water bottle
