



# FOOTBALL INFORMATION



## WHERE:

Games are played on Saturday mornings during terms 2 & 3 at schools in the Southern Region. Year 2/3 matches will commence at 8.30am and will be finished by 9.30am. Year 4/5 matches will commence at 9:30am and will be finished by 10:30am. Year 6/7 matches will commence at 10:30am and will be finished by around 11:30am. It is incorporated within the West Adelaide Football Club School Football Association.

## WHO AND WHEN:

Football is defined by year levels and will depend on the number of registration forms we receive, as to what year level teams will be nominated. Generally, the year you turn 8 is the year you can play football.

## UNIFORMS:

The school will provide the Guernseys, but **you** will need to provide:

- Green shorts
- Gold socks
- drink bottle
- mouth guard
- football boots

Guernseys will need to be washed at the end of the season and returned to the school **prior** to the Trophy Presentation Night.

## WEATHER POLICY

You will need to turn up for **every** match and play. The only time matches will be cancelled is if **your coach** is advised that the weather warning states "electrical/lightning" and they in turn, will contact you.

## HOW CAN PARENTS VOLUNTEER?

*The coach* will be required to have a DCSI criminal history clearance and the small fee will be paid by the school. These forms are available from your Football Convenor or the school front office. The coach position can be shared or a roster system can be put in place. They will need to be available for practice nights and for Saturday Matches. After hours practice is usually on a weeknight after school and is dependent on the coach's availability.

*The Team Manager* will be required to co-ordinate a parent volunteer roster system for home games. This roster will provide a scorer, people to put up the goals and take them down. Usually the weekly captain provides the half time oranges.
