

NETBALL INFORMATION

WHERE AND WHEN:

Games are played on **Saturday mornings** at schools in the Southern Region. It is incorporated within the Southern Area Junior Netball Association. The season dates are yet to be confirmed but are during Term 2 & 3. Parents will be notified of the dates as soon as they become available. There are no games on long weekends or during the July School Holidays.

WHAT YEAR LEVEL:

Boys and Girls are welcome from Year levels 2 to 7. Netball teams are defined by year levels. Nominated teams will be dependent on the number of registration forms we receive. Generally, the rule of thumb is:

Years 2 & 3	Netta rules (modified Netta rules)
Years 4 - 7	Netball rules (Official Netball Rules)

Please note that there are no ladders or finals.

UNIFORMS:

The school will provide each player with a polo shirt and bibs, but **you** will need to provide:

- Bottle Green netball skirt
 - White socks & Sneakers
 - Drink bottle

COACHES:

Each team requires either, a coach, team manager or adult supervisor. Weekly training can be organised at the school, but will depend on the coach/team manager/adult supervisor's availability. There are Coaching clinics run by Netball Australia (fee paid by the school) for anyone wishing to coach a team.

Any person wishing to volunteer for After School Sports will need to complete a Volunteer Application Form, attend a Volunteer Induction session held at the school and participate in the Responding to Abuse and Neglect Education and Care (RAN-EC) induction session for volunteers.

WET WEATHER POLICY:

SAJNA RULES STATE 'All teams must attend scheduled matches in wet weather conditions. It should then be left to the discretion of the umpires and coaches whether the games should commence or continue. In the event of a mutual decision not being reached between coaches and umpire, the umpire will be responsible for making the final decision.'

UMPIRES:

We are also in need of umpires for the home game matches. Umpires are paid for each game umpired. Each team will require a parent/adult to assist with Timekeeping and Scoring for each game.

PRESENTATIONS:

Trophy presentation will be held at the end of Term 3, on the weekend, with a snack & drink provided for all players.
