WHERE & WHEN:

Games are played on Saturday mornings during Terms 2 & 3 at schools in the Southern Region. It is incorporated within the Southern Districts Junior Soccer Association.

WHO CAN PLAY?

Soccer is defined by year child was born and school year level. Team allocation will depend on the number of registration forms we receive. Generally, rule of thumb is:

Age Group	Team
Year 6/7	Seniors
Year 5/6	Under 11
Year 4/5	Under 10
Year 3/2	Under 9
Year 2	Under 8

******Girls as well as boys are encouraged to have a go!******

To play children must have turned 7 years old by the commencement of the season (usually around mid May)

UNIFORMS:

The school will provide the tops, but you will need to provide:

- Green shorts
- Gold Socks
- Shin Guards
- Boots
- Mouth guard (optional)

Each team requires a coach, referee and lines person. The coach is required to have a DCSI criminal history clearance (fee will be paid by school and forms are available from convenor).

After hours practise is usually on a week night after school and is dependent on the coaches' availability.

Trophy presentation is generally held at the end of Term 3, on a Saturday morning with a snack and drink provided for players.
