

BASKETBALL INFORMATION

WHERE AND WHEN:

Games are played at either the Marion, Mitchell Park, Springbank (Pasadena) or Blackwood Recreation Centre Stadiums after school during the week. The season dates will be confirmed prior to games starting during Term 1 & 4. Parents will be notified of the dates as soon as they become available. There are no games during the School Holidays.

WHAT YEAR LEVEL:

Boys and Girls are welcome from Year levels 1 to 6. Basketball teams are defined by year levels. Nominated teams will be dependent on the number of registrations we receive. Generally, the rule of thumb is:

Year 1 Friday
Year 2 Wednesday

Year 3 Tuesday or Wednesday
Year 4 Tuesday or Wednesday
Year 5 Monday or Friday
Year 6 Monday or Thursday

Please note that there are no ladders or finals.

UNIFORMS:

The school will provide each player with a basketball top, but **you** will need to provide:

- Bottle Green shorts
- Sneakers
- Drink bottle

COACHES:

Each team requires either, a coach, team manager or adult supervisor. Weekly training can be organised at the school, but will depend on the coach/team manager/adult supervisor's availability.

Any person wishing to volunteer for Out of School Hours Sports will need to complete a Volunteer Application Form, attend a Volunteer Induction session held at the school and participate in the Responding to Abuse and Neglect Education and Care (RAN-EC) induction session for volunteers.

HOT WEATHER POLICY:

Basketball rules state – some games will be cancelled if the forecast temperature is above a certain level for non- air conditioned venues. Those teams effected by this will be notified by the coach.

UMPIRES:

Umpires are provided for each game at the stadiums. Each team will require a parent/adult to assist with scoring for each game.

PRESENTATIONS:

Trophy presentation will be held at the end of the season.
