

CRICKET INFORMATION

WHERE AND WHEN:

Master Blaster games are played on **Saturday mornings** at Reynella Oval. A, B & C Grade games are played at various schools in the Southern Region on **Friday Afternoons** (C Grade) and **Saturday mornings** (A & B Grade). The season dates are yet to be confirmed but usually start within the first 2-3 weeks of Term 1 and week 2 of Term 4. Parents will be notified of the dates as soon as they become available. There are no games on long weekends or during the School Holidays.

WHAT YEAR LEVEL:

Boys and Girls are welcome from Year levels 2 to 7. Cricket teams are defined by both year levels and **ability**. Nominated teams will be dependent on the number of registration forms we receive. Generally, the rule of thumb is:

Years 2 & 3 (Master Blaster)	A fun introduction to the game
Years 4 & 5 (C Grade)	A modified game emphasis on development and participation
Years 5 & 6 (B Grade)	A modified game emphasis on development and participation
Years 6 & 7 (A Grade)	Advanced games for experienced children

Please note that there are no ladders or finals.

UNIFORMS:

The school will provide each player with a polo shirt, but **you** will need to provide:

- Bottle Green school shorts or White Cricket pants
- Wide brimmed hat
- Sneakers
- Sunscreen
- Drink bottle

COACHES:

Each team requires either, a coach, team manager or adult supervisor. Weekly training can be organised at the school, but will depend on the coach/team manager/adult supervisor's availability. There are Coaching clinics run by the South Australian Cricket Association (fee paid by the school) for anyone wishing to coach a team. Any person wishing to volunteer for Out of School Hours Sports will need to complete a Volunteer Application Form, attend a Volunteer Induction session held at the school and participate in the Responding to Abuse and Neglect Education and Care (RAN-EC) induction session for volunteers.

HOT WEATHER POLICY:

Each school will have its own Heat Policy that needs to be adhered to. Each coach will be required to correspond with the opposing school coach to determine if games are to be cancelled due to the Heat.

UMPIRES:

Each team will require a parent/adult to act as an umpire and assist with scoring for each game.

PRESENTATIONS:

Trophy presentation will be held at the end of Term 4, on the weekend, with a snack & drink provided for all players.
