

FOOTBALL INFORMATION

WHERE AND WHEN:

Games are played on **Saturday mornings** at Seaview High School, Seacombe Gardens. It is incorporated within the West Adelaide Football Club School Football Association. The season dates are yet to be confirmed but are during Term 2 & 3. Parents will be notified of the dates as soon as they become available. There are no games on long weekends or during the School Holidays.

WHAT YEAR LEVEL:

Boys and Girls are welcome from Year levels 1 to 6. Football is defined by year levels. Nominated teams will be dependent on the number of registration forms we receive. Generally, the rule of thumb is:

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| Years 1 & 2 | A fun introduction to the game (Year 1 students must have completed the Auskick program before playing school football) |
| Years 3 & 4 | A modified game emphasis on development and participation |
| Years 5 & 6 | Advanced games for experienced children |

Please note that there are no ladders or finals.

UNIFORMS:

The school will provide each player with a Guernsey, but **you** will need to provide:

- Bottle Green shorts
 - Gold football socks
 - Football boots
 - Mouth Guard
 - Drink bottle
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COACHES:

Each team requires either, a coach, team manager or adult supervisor. Weekly training can be organised at the school, but will depend on the coach/team manager/adult supervisor's availability. There are Coaching clinics run by the AFL (fee paid by the school) for anyone wishing to coach a team.

Any person wishing to volunteer for Out of School Hours Sports will need to complete a Volunteer Application Form, attend a Volunteer Induction session held at the school and participate in the Responding to Abuse and Neglect Education and Care (RAN-EC) induction session for volunteers.

WEATHER POLICY:

Players are expected to turn up for every match. Games will only be cancelled when the weather warning includes electrical/lightning storms.

UMPIRES:

Umpires for each game will be supplied by the SANFL. Each team will require a parent/adult to act as a goal umpire and assist with Timekeeping and Scoring for each game.

PRESENTATIONS:

Trophy presentation will be held at the end of Term 3, on the weekend.
