

SOCCER INFORMATION

WHERE AND WHEN:

Games are played on **Saturday mornings** at schools in the Southern Region. It is incorporated within the Southern Districts Junior Soccer Association. The season dates are yet to be confirmed but are during Term 2 & 3. Parents will be notified of the dates as soon as they become available. There are no games on long weekends or during the July School Holidays.

WHAT YEAR LEVEL:

Boys and Girls are welcome from Year levels 2 to 7. Soccer is defined by the year each child was born and school year level. Nominated teams will be dependent on the number of registration forms we receive. Generally, the rule of thumb is:

Years 2	Under 8
Years 2 & 3	Under 9
Years 4 & 5	Under 10
Years 5 & 6	Under 11
Years 6 & 7	Seniors

Please note that children must have turned 7 years old by the commencement of the season (usually around mid-May). There are no ladders or finals.

UNIFORMS:

The school will provide each player with a Guernsey, but **you** will need to provide:

- Bottle Green shorts
 - Gold socks
 - Football boots
 - Shin Guards
 - Drink bottle

COACHES:

Each team requires either, a coach, team manager or adult supervisor. Weekly training can be organised at the school, but will depend on the coach/team manager/adult supervisor's availability.

Any person wishing to volunteer for After School Sports will need to complete a Volunteer Application Form, attend a Volunteer Induction session held at the school and participate in the Responding to Abuse and Neglect Education and Care (RAN-EC) induction session for volunteers.

WEATHER POLICY:

Players are expected to turn up for every match. Games will only be cancelled when the weather warning includes electrical/lightning storms.

UMPIRES:

Each team will require a parent/adult to act as a referee, lines person and assist with Timekeeping and Scoring for each game.

PRESENTATIONS:

Trophy presentation will be held at the end of Term 3, on the weekend, with a snack & drink provided for all players.
